





Extensive research and development enable us to constantly push the boundaries of marine evacuation with visionary solutions such as the VIKING VEDS Helix and VIKING LifeCraft[™].

The VIKING Evacuation Dual Slide system, VEDS Helix, consists of steel frame, a chute-box, a sledge for liferaft containers and a deployment winch. The liferaft containers are mounted on the sledge by means of lashing straps.

Additional liferafts can be positioned near to the VEDS Helix system and released by means of a remote release system, either pneumatical or electrical system.

A connection line ensures connection between additional liferafts and the inflated VEDS system.

- Assist rescue and recovery vessels or aircraft







VIKING Evacuation Dual Chute (VEDC)

The evacuation dual chute, VEDC, is VIKING's highest capacity chute system with an evacuation capacity of 908 people in 30 minutes. It is combined with 153 person liferafts for safe, rapid evacuation from large passenger carrying vessels.

This unique design combines the highest evacuation capacity with discreet, compact and self-contained design for maximum safety and relatively little deck disruption.

Each VEDC system contains two 153 person liferafts. Capacity can be increased to suit the exact ship requirements with additional drop liferafts.





VIKING Evacuation MiniChute (VEMC)

The VIKING Evacuation MiniChute VEMC is based on the full size VIKING Evacuation Chute. The system is designed especially for small and medium sized vessels with embarkation heights of 6.1-20.2 metres.

This self contained system provides rapid and safe evacuation directly into the liferafts. The self-righting liferaft is pre-installed onto the chutesystem and inflates automatically with one simple pull on the slip hook. The VEMC system can be installed anywhere onboard; on open deck or between decks in an open recess with a float free unit.

The MiniChute can be supplied with 101 or 153 person liferafts and can evacuate 582 people in 30 minutes.

VIKING Evacuation Slide (VES)

The slide is a stable, efficient dry-shod evacuation system that can evacuate over 657 people in 30 minutes. It can be tailor-made to suit all types of vessels and is available with self-righting 25, 51 or 101 person liferaft combinations.

The 30° angle between slide and ship absorbs the movement of the sea and means that the system can be installed at extreme forward and aft positions. The slide is fitted with lines that allow for access up the slide, allowing it to also function as a means of rescue.





VIKING VELS with SOLAS Mini Slide

This MiniSlide system is designed for low embarkation vessels with independent slide and liferaft. The system requires only one crew member to operate and oversee evacuation.

The MiniSlide system has a 153 person liferaft, available with or without canopy to suit both open sea and protected waters. The systems can evacuate 501 people in 30 minutes and 303 people in 17 minutes and 40 seconds.





VIKING Automatic Slide (VAS)

VIKING has developed a 153 person open reversible liferaft and minislide system packed into a single aluminum stowage box. The real magic of this system lies in its one-button, oneperson release and operation.


The VAS system is designed and certified for vessels on domestic voyages such as ferries sailing in protected waters. It enables crew to evacuate up to 153 people in one go and is designed for evacuation heights between 1.5 - 3.65 metres. The VAS system is very easy to install. It comes in a box that is placed flush with the ship side, bolted to the deck and ready to go. No bowsing lines or welded connection points on the ship side are necessary.





VIKING Simple Bowsing System (SBS)

The Simple Bowsing System (SBS) for High-Speed Craft (HSC) and smaller ferries is designed for evacuating 51, 101 and 153 persons safely in a convenient, cost-effective package. The liferaft container is installed on the vessel close to the evacuation door and the slide is packed in a valise stored nearby. The VIKING SBS is available in direct-boarding liferaft configurations, or with SOLASapproved slides in three different sizes for various evacuation heights. Can be installed with either standard liferafts or liferafts with extended service intervals such as the VIKING S30.





VIKING Undertun

The VIKING Undertun is a compact, open gangway system for walking or sliding directly into the liferaft.

Half of the gangway has a friction surface for walking down at low angles, the other half has a plane surface that allows evacuees to slide into the liferaft.

The system has an integrated 12V battery and is launched at the push of a button on the box or from the bridge. No electrical connections are necessary. This system is available with self-righting, canopied liferafts in sizes 150 persons, or with an open reversible liferaft for 100 persons.





VIKING Evacuation MiniSlide (VEMS)

This system is designed for small vessels operating in any sea condition. It is available with either a 101 person open reversible liferaft for vessels operating in sheltered waters or a SOLAS compliant 101 person self-righting canopied liferaft for vessels operating at sea.

It is packed in a container the size of a standard liferaft container, simple to operate and fully operational within 2 minutes. The VEMS can evacuate 303 people in 17 minutes and 40 seconds and 501 people in 30 minutes.



Liferafts



Throw-overboard liferafts

Throw overboard liferafts are designed to be dropped overboard in the container and inflated in the water.

Self-righting canopied rafts are available in four sizes; 25, 51, 101 and 153 persons. Standard canopied rafts are available in eight sizes; 6, 8, 10,12, 16, 20, 25 and 35 persons. Open reversible liferafts, for use in sheltered waters are available for: 6, 12, 20, 25, 51, 101 and 153 persons.

Liferafts with capacities of 25 and above can be used as supplementary liferafts to all VIKING marine evacuation systems.



Davit launched liferafts (DKF, DKFS)

Davit launched liferafts are designed to be inflated and boarded at deck level, and then lowered into the water.

They are available as self-righting canopied liferafts or standard canopied liferafts.

They are designed to carry 12, 25, 35 or 39 persons and are an effective means of dry-shod evacuation and can either be an alternative to chute or slide systems or a supplement.



VIKING liferafts are designed in accordance with SOLAS Chapter III and LSA Code requirements, and are MED, RMRS, Canadian Coast Guard and AMSA approved

Our wide range of throw-overboard and davitlaunchable liferafts are available in a standard version and a top-of-the-line, automatically self-righting version with stowage heights of up to 60 m.

VIKING also supplies cradles, hooks, davits, sliding racks and columns racks.

Our proven self-righting liferafts ensure that no matter how a liferaft lands in the water, it will always right itself ready for boarding. Liferafts can also be equipped with a hydrostatic release unit so they inflate automatically if they have not been released manually.

VIKING liferafts are subjected to wind velocity tests at forces of 30 m per second and deployed at extremely low temperatures.

VIKING S30s are serviced using a combination of annual onboard inspections carried out by crew and specialized service after 30 months at a VIKING certified service station.

At 30 months the liferaft must be serviced at a VIKING S30 certified servicing. A current list is available in the VIKING S30 Portal or from your local VIKING office.

We've done our best to make it even easier for you, too:

- Our VIKING S30 Portal contains everything there is to know for servicing tasks.
- Personnel achieve certification via online e-learning programs and reporting.
- Instructions, troubleshooting and reporting are all in one place and accessible at any location with an internet connection.

What exactly is an extended service interval liferaft?

Extended service interval liferafts are permitted under SOLAS regulation 20.8.3, which enables liferafts to be inspected at longer intervals than 12 months, as long as the same safety levels are met as for conventional liferafts.

Less handling

The liferafts must be annually tested on board by trained and certified personnel, but require less handling than conventional products. So they carry lower associated costs (such as barge, overtime and transportation) than conventional liferafts.

More planning

Service dates are based on the date of manufacture, and no extensions are allowed – or grace periods for dated items. Extended service interval liferafts can only be serviced at specially equipped, approved service stations.

Similar costs

Experience shows that, in the long run, higher costs of specialised services and the need to carry out replacement at authorized servicing stations result in a similar overall cost level between extended service interval and conventional liferafts.



Documentation

- Liferaft is received and registered
- Logbook in the liferaft is completed (proof that the liferaft has been opened and tested)
- Inspection is performed using VIKING approved inspection checklist
- Certificate of re-inspection is issued
- Full documentation for service is archived according to regulations
- Detailed invoice is issued

Service

- Liferaft is removed from the container and the inflation system dismounted
- Container shell is cleaned and fibreglass is repaired if needed
- Container is relabelled
- Liferaft is inspected inside and out
- Emergency pack is checked and items replaced if expired according to regulations
- Liferaft equipment is inspected and replaced if needed
- Cylinder operating head, valve, knife and release wire is inspected

- CO, cylinder is checked for correct content level
- Inflation systems and high pressure hoses are inspected
- Liferaft is deflated, repacked in the container and prepared for dispatch

Testing

- Liferaft is inflated with compressed air and pressure tested including a 60 min. working pressure test of the lower buoyancy chamber, upper buoyancy chamber and arch chamber
- If the liferaft is equipped with an inflatable floor, this is pressure tested for 60 min.

Liferaft is subjected to specific tests at various intervals according to international regulations.

- Gas inflation test (GI) is conducted every 5 years using the liferaft's CO₂ cylinder to inflate the liferaft
- Necessary additional pressure test (NAP) at double the working pressure rate is conducted at 11 years end then annually thereafter
- Floor seam test (FS) is performed to check the seams of the internal floor and is conducted at 11 years and then annually thereafter




